



Classroom Questionnaire

As you begin to plan your residency, keep in mind that the classroom teacher is responsible for classroom management and **must be in the room with the design/building professional at all times**. The following questions are touch points on classroom culture to prepare the professional for student and classroom interaction. The teacher is always expected to enforce classroom discipline and manage any student issues that arise.

Teachers: Please make sure students are wearing name tags when the professional comes to your classroom

1. What methods are used in the classroom to get students' attention?
2. If there are disruptors, what are the ways the teacher normally handles them to regain control of the classroom?
3. What supplies are at the students' desks and what supplies are located elsewhere in the classroom that they might need on a regular basis?
4. When using supplies that are not at students' desks, how does the teacher usually distribute them?
5. What other classroom/school policies does the professional need to know? Does the school require another background check in addition to AFO's?
6. What is the check-in procedure for volunteers in the school office?
7. Does the professional or teacher have any expectations about working with the students that have not yet been addressed?
