

**Elements of Design Worksheet***Elements of Design*

Follow this worksheet as you watch the *Elements of Design* lesson video. Pay attention to the design details around you and look for things you have never noticed before! Write or draw your responses on this worksheet or on another piece of paper.

**1st Element of Design: LINE**

Look around the building or space you are in. Where do you see lines? Write down or draw what you see. (Examples to look for: where two walls meet, the edge of a door, the edge of a window)

**2nd Element of Design: SHAPE**

Continue to look around the building or space you are in. What shapes do you see? Write down or draw what you see. (Examples to look for: shape of a window, shape of a brick, shape of a roof)

**3rd Element of Design: SIZE**

How big or small is the building you are in? If you are outside, how big or small are the buildings near you and how do they compare in size to each other? Think about how you feel in big buildings versus small buildings. Write down or draw what you see and feel.

**4th Element of Design: SPACE**

Look in front of you, to your sides, behind you and look up. Do you have a lot or a little bit of space around you? Do you prefer wide open or smaller spaces? Write down or draw what you see and how it makes you feel.

**5th Element of Design: COLOR**

Continue to look around. Do you see a lot or a little bit of color? If you could paint the walls, what color or colors would you choose? Do you prefer to be in bright colored spaces or neutral colored spaces? Write down or draw what you see and how you would change the colors within your space.

**6th Element of Design: VALUE**

Find something colorful in your space. What is the value of the colors you see? Light values are closer to white, and dark values are closer to black. Write down or draw what you see.

**7th Element of Design: TEXTURE**

Look around the space you are in. Look at the walls, the floor, the ceiling and any other surfaces. How many different textures can you find? Write down or draw what you see.
