Eligibility & Criteria

Undergraduate or graduate student currently enrolled in University of Oregon or Portland State University architecture program (undergraduate and graduate students are evaluated based on the merits of their experience)

Commitment to community service outside of school and relative to applicant's community

Demonstrated ability for quality architectural design

Application Requirements

We transitioned our application process to a platform called Submittable. Applicants must now submit proposals electronically through an application form. You will be asked to make a free account through Submittable, which will allow you to save drafts as you work through the application and allow you to access your submitted application at any time.

Application Deadline: Friday, February 26, 2021, 11:59 PM

500 word (maximum) essay outlining your experience with community service and how you aspire to use architecture and design to address a challenge facing either your specific community or Oregonians in general. How does your experience and aspirations support the mission of AFO?

Design portfolio with three examples of work – maximum three pages per project

- Can feature architecture or community focused projects
- Must include one project completed individually (not a group project)
- If including group projects, describe your role in the project
- If applicable, please include a project illustrating an architectural design that responds to a community need or challenge

Two letters of recommendation addressing your achievements, potential in design and commitment to community service – letters must not exceed one page and must be emailed directly by the recommender to candice@af-oregon.org

- One letter from architectural faculty
- One letter from a community member

Previous applicants who have not received an award are welcome and encouraged to reapply.
