Materials List

Recommended Materials and Supplies:

- Printed Student Architect Journal
- Several sheets of paper (different kinds encouraged!)
- Old magazines or other printed images to cut up (optional)
- Pencil and eraser
- Colored pencils, markers or crayons (something to color with)
- Scissors
- Glue or tape
- Ruler
- Old sock or small paper bag (for making a puppet)
- Any additional art supplies or craft materials you have around your home!

Final Project Materials

Students have the option to design and build a bee habitat, a bird or butterfly feeder, or a mini garden. Recommended materials will depend on what they choose to build.

- Recycled materials or anything around your home that can be used for model building (i.e. cans, bottles and cups, shallow plate or pie tin, milk cartons, cardboard, toilet paper rolls, old t-shirts, etc.)
- Hollow tubes, corrugated cardboard or plastic straws needing recycling (Do not purchase plastic straws. This is an option to use up straws needing recycling only!)
- Twine or string
- Paint and paintbrushes (acrylic paint is recommended to withstand outdoor conditions)
- Craftsticks/popsicle sticks
- For bee habitats: sticks, leaves, bark and/or pinecones
- For bird/butterfly feeders: sugar & water, fruit & honey, or nectar flower seeds & soil
- For mini gardens: soil and beneficial flower seeds

Additional Bonus Challenge Materials:

Daily bonus challenges are optional, but are a fun way to keep your student engaged in design learning!

- More of the materials listed above
- S'mores ingredients: graham crackers, marshmallows and chocolate
- Recycled pizza box (or another shallow cardboard box)
- Black construction paper
- Aluminum foil
- Plastic wrap or clear compostable wrap
