Hermann Colas Jr. is a proud Haitian, American, and Vietnam Veteran, as well as a distinguished scholar, and civic and business leader who has dedicated his life's work to strengthening communities. Hermann's story began in 1948 in Port-Au-Prince, Haiti, where he learned how to lead as the eldest of eight siblings. His love for his family and the family home remained central to his career path and mission, eventually leading to the founding of Colas Construction (COLAS), a general contracting firm headquartered in Portland, now owned and operated by his three children.

Preceded by his six-year service in the U.S. Army, Hermann graduated from Portland State University with a double major in computer science and mathematics. He went on to serve over 20 years as a business executive, working at USWEST in leadership roles.

In 1997, Hermann pursued his longtime goal of starting a family business. He founded Colas Construction with a vision to address underinvestment in housing in the predominantly Black and Brown neighborhoods of North and Northeast Portland. Today, with an impressive portfolio of housing for countless families, COLAS is nationally and locally recognized for delivering excellence in construction for a diverse scope of projects in retail, education, civic, healthcare, and housing.
