

Materials List

Recommended Materials and Supplies:

- Printed Student Architect Journal (this will be emailed to you the week before camp begins)
- Several sheets of paper (different kinds and colors encouraged!)
- Tempura paint and paintbrushes
- Pencil and eraser
- Colored pencils, markers or crayons (something to color with)
- Scissors
- Glue and/or tape
- Ruler or straight edge
- Old magazines or other printed images to cut up (optional)
- Any additional art supplies or craft materials you have around your home!

Final Project Materials:

Students will be designing a monument for a person or group of people who deserve to be honored, but have not historically been. Recommended materials for their final model will depend on what they design.

- More of the materials listed above
- Recycled materials or anything around your home that can be used for model building
 (i.e. cans, bottles and cups, cereal boxes, milk cartons, cardboard, toilet paper rolls, etc.),
 corrugated cardboard or plastic straws needing recycling (do not purchase plastic straws,
 this is an option to use up straws needing recycling only!)
- Twine or string
- Craftsticks/popsicle sticks

Additional Bonus Challenge Materials:

Daily bonus challenges are optional, but are a fun way to keep your student engaged in design learning!

- More of the materials listed above
- One 12 x 18 inch and two 8.5 x 11 inch sheets of cardstock
- Old sock or small paper bag (for making a puppet)
