

Project Display Guidelines for Architects in Schools 2024 In-person Exhibits in Portland Metro Area

The Portland Architects in Schools Exhibits will occur at several venues in the tri-county Portland area.

All venues will have a reception for students and families. Please plan to **finish your residency by the end of April** if possible to ensure that projects are complete and dry enough to transport to a venue (for events later in May, you will have more time.) If you would like to exhibit at a specific venue, please plan for your final project to work within the constraints of the space (i.e. some venues only have space for table top projects, not wall projects).

Please remember that projects must be able to fit into the designated space for that venue AND must have any 3-D work/details strongly secured to a base. Portland Metro Area Display Venues

BRIC Architecture

BRICis located at 1233 NW 12th Ave. in Portland (Pearl District). Guests can call 503-595-4900 to make an appointment to see the exhibit if they can't attend the First Thursday event. Each class at this location must be able to fit all of the project(s) into a space no larger than **2 feet by 8 feet per class (or can instead be 6 feet by 4 feet for wall projects).** This space lends itself mainly to table top projects. There is limited wall hanging space. The event for this venue will be during First Thursday, May 2 (5:30-7:30pm).

DLR Group

DLR Group is located at 110 SW Yamhill St., Ste 105 in Portland (Downtown) with an open first floor display area. Guests can call 503-274-2675 to make an appointment to see the exhibit if they can't attend the First Thursday event. Each class at this location must be able to fit all of the project(s) into a space no larger than **2 feet by 8 feet per class**. This space supports only table top projects. The event for this venue will be during First Thursday, May 2 (5:30-7:30pm).

Opsis Architecture

Opsis Architecture is located at 920 NW 17th Ave. in Portland (Northwest District) with a first floor display area that is open during business hours (9:00 am – 5:00 pm). (Please call 503-525-9511 if door is locked during business hours when you arrive.) Each class at this location must be able to fit all of the project(s) into a space no larger than 2 feet by 8 feet per class (or can instead be 6 feet by 4 feet for wall projects). Opsis lends itself to both wall and table mounted projects. Schools that would like to display both a 3-D project accompanied by a wall piece are encouraged to display work at this location. The event for this venue will be during First Thursday, May 2 (5:30-7:30pm).

OMSI

The Oregon Museum of Science and Industry is at 1945 SE Water Ave. in Portland (East Waterfront). We will have a set amount of display space. Each class at this location must be able to fit all of the project(s) into a space no larger than **2 feet by 8 feet per class.** This space lends itself only to table top projects. OMSI will host some programming related to students' work, and other help from teachers and design professionals may be asked for as well. The reception for OMSI will be a special day on Saturday, May 18 (11:30am-5:00pm) for students and families.

Portland Community College Rock Creek Campus

The PCC Rock Creek Campus Library is located at 17705 NW Springville Rd. (Building 9) in NW Portland with an open second floor display area open during <u>business</u> <u>hours</u>. Each class at this location must be able to fit all of the project(s) into a space no larger than **2 feet by 6 feet per class** and the space lends itself best to individual or smaller group projects. If you are concerned about fitting your class's project(s) into this space, please contact Kim (<u>kim@aforegon.org</u>) to discuss options. This space supports only table top projects. The event for this venue will be on Saturday, May 4 from 2:00-4:00pm.

Multnomah County Library, Rockwood Branch

The Rockwood Library is located at 17917 SE Stark St. in SE Portland. There will be options to view projects outside of the event if families can't attend. Each class at this location must be able to fit all of the project(s) into a space no larger than **2 feet by 6 feet per class** and the space lends itself best to individual or smaller group projects. If you are concerned about fitting your class's project(s) into this space, please contact Kim (kim@af-oregon.org) to discuss options. This space supports only table top projects. The event for this venue will be on Thursday, May 9 from 4:30-6:00pm.
